What is Johns Hopkins' affiliation with APICS?

Johns Hopkins has licensed e-courses from Skillsoft. Although Skillsoft does not offer courseware that is aligned toward APICS certification programs, their courses cover a wide range of subjects that support the professional development of APICS certification holders, and the time spent in training with many Skillsoft courses can be applied toward the accumulation of professional development points, which are required to maintain a certification. These courses are available to you as a full- or part-time employee of Johns Hopkins.

Certification

APICS offers two certification programs:

- Certified in Production and Inventory Management (CPIM)
- Management Certified Supply Chain Professional (CSCP)

APICS certifications are recognized worldwide as standards of professional excellence and quality within the manufacturing and service industries.

Maintaining a Certification

The APICS Certification Maintenance Program uses professional development points as a way for certification holders to track their certification maintenance activities. APICS CPIM and APICS CSCP designees must earn a total of 75 professional development points within five years of receiving their designation.

APICS offers certification holders a wide range of activities for achieving professional development points to fit into each person's professional circumstances and his/her career development plans. Continuing education is among those activities, and Skillsoft's Business Skills and IT courseware libraries include hundreds of courses that may be eligible for 3 professional development points for each course completed.
